



STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Established in 2019 during the 50th anniversary year of the Ohio State Chiropractic Association, the Ohio Chiropractic Foundation Student Scholarship Program recognizes chiropractic students who are committed to shaping the future of the profession and practicing in the state of Ohio. Applicants will be evaluated on their potential to become leaders for the chiropractic profession, as demonstrated by involvement in school and community activities, and academic performance. The 2024 Anniversary Scholarship, awarded by the Ohio Chiropractic Foundation, will be presented at the 2024 OSCA Annual Convention membership meeting on Friday, October 4, 2024.

GENERAL ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Student Member of the OSCA (Membership is free). Visit www.oscachiro.org to join.
- Complete at least two academic years in a Chiropractic school setting.
- Earn a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent grading system) in professional course work during chiropractic school.
- Student must be willing to reside and practice in the state of Ohio and commit to helping shape the future of the profession after graduation.

APPLICATION

Applicants must:

- Complete the scholarship application form.
- Submit a transcript to verify your GPA. GPA must be clearly visible or highlighted. An unofficial transcript in PDF or Word format is acceptable.
- Submit an essay of up to 500 words describing how the applicant would help in the future to advance the chiropractic profession in the state of Ohio.
- A letter of recommendation that is an academic-based reference letter from a college official or faculty member. This letter should come from an official who can speak to the applicant's leadership and involvement in his/her school. Recommenders may submit letters directly to the Ohio State Chiropractic Association. Letters may be sent via email at foundation@ oscachiro.org
- Submit a current resume or CV.

SUBMISSION PROCESS

A completed application consists of an application form, transcript with GPA value, essay, letter of recommendation, and a resume/CV. Please include your name on all documents submitted. These documents must be received by 11:59 PM (EST) on Friday, August 9, 2024 to theaddress or via the email address foundation@oscachiro.org

SCORING SCALE & SELECTION PROCESS

The Ohio Chiropractic Foundation Board of Directors will review applications and score them according to the criteria submitted:

- Academic Performance
- Chiropractic-related Activities on Campus (Ohio club, etc)
- Non-Chiropractic/Community Activities
- Essay
- Letter of Recommendation

*The scholarship recipient will e notified via mail by and phone by Monday September 9, 2024 Attendance at the 2024 OSCA Annual Convention Awards ceremony is strongly encouraged, however not required. Student admission is free of charge.
